

Stanton IB Diploma Program Requirements and Recommendations Checklist

This is everything. If all of these items are completed on time, the IB Diploma is in the bag (presuming mastery of content for the subject exams).

Requirements

- Exam registration to Coordinator (Sept of 11th grade and 12th grade)
- Exam registration verification with liability agreement to Coordinator (Oct. of 11th and 12th)
- Internal Assessments for IB courses (Students should write down dates as soon as each teacher announces it)

Group 1 – Language A	Oral (March-June of 11 th), World Lit Essay (Jan. of 12 th)
Group 2 – Language B	Oral Written Assign.
Group 3 – IB Contemp.	Historical Investigation
Group 4 – Exp. Science	Lab write-ups Group 4 Project
Group 5 – Mathematics	Math project or exploration
Group 6 – Elective	Varied by subject

- Theory of Knowledge components
 - Firm grasp of “Eight Ways of Knowing” and “Eight Areas of Knowledge” (First semester of 11th)
 - Oral presentation
 - 1200-1600 word essay on one of six prescribed titles/prompts
- Extended Essay
 - Identify topic from approved list (November-December of 11th)
 - Initial supervisor meeting (January of 11th)
 - Research and thesis development (January-February of 11th)
 - Outline of essay (February of 11th)
 - First 2000 words (early March of 11th)
 - Rough draft complete (early April of 11th)
 - Essay refinement (August of 12th)
 - Viva voce with supervisor (September to October of 12th)
 - Final draft to TOK teacher (Halloween of 12th)
- Creativity, Action, and Service
 - 50 hours of Creative
 - 50 hours of Action
 - 50 hours of Service
 - One activity “involving teamwork that integrates two or more of creativity, action and service and is of significant duration.”
 - Eight essential outcomes fulfilled (no hours logged above will count unless accompanied by the outcomes reflection document)
 - Overall CAS summary/reflection 500-1500 words
 - All CAS documentation above is due the Friday before Spring Break, 12th grade
- The IB Exams – May of 11th and 12th

Recommendations

- Each IB Exam (except for Fine Arts) consists of two or three sessions (Paper 1, Paper 2, etc...)
- Look at real past exam papers for all of your tests at freeexampapers.com
- Look at subject outlines on stantonib.weebly.com and identify what topics you need to review most heavily
- Identify different days in March to April of 12th grade as “Marathon [Insert Subject] Study Day” to review for exams
